- **6. Forgiveness as Strength:** Forgiveness is presented as a powerful tool for healing, showcasing its ability to change lives and foster reconciliation within the community.
- **7. Desire for Unity:** The theme of unity underscores the importance of communal harmony, suggesting that collective efforts in faith can lead to greater strength and purpose as a congregation.
