

IRA CHARITABLE ROLLOVER-a tax saving charitable gift for non-itemizers

Due to an increased standard deduction, many individuals and couples will no longer be able to claim itemized deductions. However a tax-free IRA charitable rollover offers the following benefits to individuals age 70 ^{1/2} or older:

- · The ability to direct a current, outright IRA gift, up to \$105,000, to CPRS or other qualified charities
- · Satisfaction of the required minimum distribution (RMD) without increasing taxable income
- · No loss of a charitable contribution itemized deduction
- · Ability to direct your donation to the operating fund, tuition assistance, or other areas of interest
- A Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD) can be a very tax-effective way to support a cause. With a QCD a check is sent directly from an IRA to CPRS allowing the donor to exclude the amount from taxable income
